Code of Conduct for Students


01. Every student should observe proper behavior, follow the discipline and the orders given by the college administration in the college.
02. If the student is found guilty of indiscipline on the college campus or outside the campus or the college finds him guilty of any kind of misbehavior, then the head of the institution can take disciplinary/punitive action against that student.
03. If the student brings any type of vehicle to the college, then the responsibility of the safety of that vehicle will be of the student himself. The college administration will not be responsible for any kind of loss.
04. Students are to strictly follow the discipline in the college campus. They are also required to behave restrainedly in the classroom, laboratory, library and participate in activities of the college with proper decorum.
05. It is mandatory for the student to attend the class regularly. According to the University Act 75% attendance is mandatory for appearing in the annual examination.
06. Students will not indulge in any kind of anti-social, political and violent activities.
07. The student will not misbehave with any employee of the college, if it is found, then strict action will be taken by the head of the institution as per rules.
08. Bringing mobile in the college campus is strictly prohibited. Apart from this, the student will not bring any valuable items in the college campus, if he does so, then in case of loss or loss, the entire responsibility will be of the student himself.
09. Students shall not damage any movable or immovable property of the college. If he does so then strict action will be taken against him.
10. The students are not to bring his outside friends or relatives to the college premises during regular classes or college programs without prior permission.
11. Each student shall carry the identity card issued by the college and present it on demand.

13. Every student is expected to read the college notice board regularly.
14. It is appealed to every student that he will cooperate in maintaining healthy academic environment in the college and will behave decently in the college and will come to the college wearing decent clothes.
15. A student can be debarred from all examinations for not attending the college regularly, not being regular in classes or for showing indiscipline.

16. The college administration will have the full right to give or deny admission, suspend or initiate action for any activity or conduct that is not conducive for maintaining a proper academic atmosphere in the college.

17. It will be mandatory for the students to follow the discipline and rules of the University and of the Higher Education Department, Government of Chhattisgarh. In case of non-compliance of the rules by the students, the Principal has full right to take disciplinary/punitive action against them.

18. From the point of view of environmental protection and cleanliness, polythene and other prohibited materials are completely banned in the college.

19. All admission related rules of the college will be applicable as per the directives issued by the Higher Education Department, Government of Chhattisgarh and Hemchand Yadav University, Durg.
